Start of New Academic Year 2017

It is a real privilege to welcome you to Ysgol Gymraeg Ystalyfera - Bro Dur's first ever newsletter! A very warm welcome to our new school which includes pupils from 3 to 18 years of age, a school which builds on the firm foundations laid by Ysgol Gyfun Ystalyfera and Ysgol Gynradd Gymraeg Y Wern. We look forward eagerly to build this new school together as a caring, creative and ambitious learning community. I would especially like to welcome those pupils who joined us in Year 7, which includes the first pupils who will start our brand new south campus, Ysgol Gymraeg Bro Dur in Port Talbot, next September.

Summer successes

A number of our pupils toured with the school on Sports visits during the summer months. One group travelled to Barbados to play Netball while a larger group travelled to Canada on a Rugby Tour. It was great to hear how these tourists impressed their hosts and were outstanding ambassadors for the school and their families. I would pay tribute to the teachers for their leadership and for the distinct good humour and courtesy of every student – you were a credit to us all! A number of students had great summer experiences and successes – in the world of athletics, performances, workshops and residential visits or in various competitions. I must commend students on some exceptional results in this summer's examinations. A Level students maintained a high standard yet again this year, as 35% of all grades were A*/A and 82% of all grades were A*-C. It was great to congratulate some outstanding results by Asia Hoile, Angharad Morgan and Cellan Michael, but in truth, so many students achieved some excellent results – congratulations to all! GCSE results were also very pleasing with Ystalyfera students' performance of a high standard. There was a depression in grades with our students reflecting the National trends as new qualifications in the core subjects were introduced. However our core subjects results: 92% in Science, 74% in English, 72% in Welsh and 68% in Mathematics were a real strength. 82% of the cohort scored 5A*-C – warm congratulations to all of them!

New Staff

It is a pleasure to welcome new staff who join us this September, Ms Sioned Jones has started her role as Deputy Head, and will have responsibility over the Bro Dur site. Mr Chris Nettle and Ms Jodie James join the Science Dept, Ms Lora Owen joins the Welsh Department and joining History are Ms Ffion Jones and Mr Richard Davies. We have two new Music teachers, Mrs Nia Davies and Mr Luke Millard and we are delighted that Mrs Rebecca Johnson joins us as Cover Supervisor. We have a few staffing changes also, Mr Kevin Davies and Mr Gareth Huxtable join the Leadership Team, Mr Davies of course as Head of the Primary Sector, and Mr Huxtable leading on data and assessment. I would wish a number of staff well in their new roles, Mrs Angharad Lloyd as Welsh Baccalaureate Co-ordinator in KS4 & KS5 and Ms Lisa Williams as her deputy; Mr Huw Rumble as Leader of D&T and Mrs Louise Edmondson as Lead of the Foundation Phase. Mrs Gwenllian Dooher has taken leadership responsibility over the SEN Support department during Mrs Hammond's maternity leave. I wish them well in their new roles.

More changes!!

The start of term has presented a number of real challenges as we have tried to cope with a number of significant changes within the school. This has been particularly true of our ITC systems as we have brand new systems and documentation. If you experienced difficulties in contacting us or in gaining a prompt reply, we apologise but we are trying our best to resolve all our communication difficulties at the start of term. We will be working diligently over the coming months to ensure all our documentation and contact details are updated, including our Twitter, Facebook accounts and websites. In the meantime, many thanks for your patience and I hope you will experience some improvements in the coming months.

Summer works

A considerable amount of work was completed on site over the summer months. The entire ground floor of the Eirion block has now been re-laid and it looks in great shape! More maintenance and improvements were made across the campus, including a new toilet block in the Nedd building. The primary block is proceeding well and according to programme, ready for a May 2018 opening. Meanwhile in Port Talbot, the Bro Dur site is changing rapidly as the construction work, again on programme ready for completion by August 2018.

Personal Organiser & “talking about your work”

Every pupil has received their individual timetable and personal organiser. We kindly ask you to check their organiser regularly in order that they keep to deadlines and their work is in order. This year we are piloting a new mentoring programme, whereby every child will be given a date where their Personal tutor will talk about their work and monitor their books. If you are able to take part in this process by talking to your son/daughter about their strengths and weaknesses this would be useful. The specific pages are in the Personal Organiser and your child should be able to explain / translate the interview questions to you.

Uniform & phones!

We will be monitoring pupils' uniform over the next few weeks – please ensure your son/daughter does not wear jeans to school – trousers should be black plain school trousers with blue shirt and school jumper and tie. Pupils are not allowed to use mobile phones in school but should keep them turned off in their possession. We thank you for your support in ensuring these expectations are met by every student.
